There are a couple of reasons why someone needs to take an email attachment and compress it in ZIP archives. The most obvious is to free up email attachment space. It is necessary to highlight that this is the case if the attachment data exceeds the size of the email body, which, on the other hand, cannot be compressed. Another reason to compress email attachments into ZIP archives is to facilitate

the transmission of attachments.

In this case, the attachment is represented by a MIME file. It is a popular format because the content of such files can be compressed. One more advantage of making email attachments into ZIP archives is that it removes attachment data from the inbox. When you receive an email and download attachments for them, you may not realize until it's too late that more data is being downloaded

than needed. If you have ever tried to clean up an inbox with many attachments, you know that this can take a lot of time.

Moreover, you have to remember how many attachments you downloaded for each email. This information is often spread out over several files. Advantages and

In the case of compressed

attachments, you can do away with attachments altogether. This means, of course, that there is no space consumed by attachment data. Facilitates the transmission of files. You can use the Zip archive to transfer files or any other data over email. You can have multiple archived files created for a single email. This can be beneficial if you are not only copying a data file but also sending a file in a separate,

attached message. Allows attachment data to be removed from the inbox. Obviously, you can do away with the attachments from the inbox.

Allows you to separate attachments from email text (in the case of MHTML messages). You won't have to keep in your head how many attachments you downloaded for each email.

Find email attachments, compress them into ZIP archives, and organize ZIPs into folders If you are a frequent mobile user, you know that your mobile contacts are also stored on your computer, and this can be very troublesome. We have already talked about mobile contacts synchronization, but finding contacts on your computer can be a quite time-

Pack Attachments is a little add-

in for Microsoft Outlook 2013 and later that makes it quick and easy to pack Outlook email attachments into ZIP archives for more free disk space. The add-in allows you to choose one or more folders in your Outlook inbox, drafts, sent, trash, archives, deleted messages or any other location. If you want to just remove attachments from your inbox, you can select this folder as well and Pack Attachments will scan this

attachments and compresses them to create ZIP archives. It requires minimum configuration and can be quickly integrated with Microsoft Outlook. To get started, it's necessary to set up your Outlook account and choose the folders that will be scanned for email attachments. You can pick anything when it comes to the inbox, drafts, sent, trash, archives, deleted messages, and any other locations. Compress Outlook

attachments into ZIP archives to make room for new data. In the following step, you just have to allow the utility time to find and process all attachments, in order to generate ZIP archives. A couple of settings can be changed before doing this, though, namely permitting Pack Attachments to proceed with the execution even after encountering errors and to decrypt secure messages. Once the task is over, you can take a

look at any email with attached messages to see that they are now packed in ZIP files instead. All ZIP archives are named "attachments.zip".
